

Materials:



Eel cut out sheet

Pencil

Pencil Sharpener

Scissors

Thumb tack

Old Chopsticks

Used disposable Coffee Cup.

Glue/glue stick



Instructions:

Wash old coffee cup.



Optional: Paint the outside of the cup and colour the eels.

Cut out eel shapes and glue as desired onto the coffee cup.





Using pencil sharpener sharpen thinner end of the chopstick this is for making different shaped holes. (Sharp pencils, knitting needles or biros will work too).



You can use a pencil to draw designs or free hand. Then using the push pin/tack make holes to trace the pattern. Remember not to make your holes too close.

Using the tack makes it easier to get the thicker chopstick or pencil through the cup. Fill in the space with smaller holes made by the tack.







I bought a packet of two LED tea light candles for \$2.00 from a local coin save store.

You could add a handle by threading string or wool through if you wanted.
