We are entering the time of Matariki the Māori New Year, here are some Tuna & Whetū shadow puppets to create and bring with you to the More FM Mata Riki Kidsfest Parade.

Tuna, are also known as ‘Hao’ by Ngāi Tahu, they are endemic to New Zealand. They are also endangered, so lets take care of our tuna!

## NGĀ RAUEMI – MATERIALS

You will need;

- Some firm paper or card (a Weetbix box will work well)
- Coloured pencils, felts or paint
- A skewer or stick
- Tape or glue

## MAHI TOI – ART MAKING

1. Cut out the Tuna from the template, lay it on your card trace around it and then cut it out.
2. Colour in or paint your Tuna cutout.
3. Attach your Tuna cutout to your skewer or stick with tape or glue.
4. Hold it in front of your torch or phone torch and there you have your own Tuna shadow puppet, to bring to the More FM Mata Riki Kidsfest Parade!
5. Feel free to cut out the Whetū and create Whetū shadow puppets as well.
6. Extension, for those keen artists! You may like to create your own Tuna design. if you have a craft knife you can create some cuts on the inside of the eel design to show the fins.

Have fun creating your Tuna & Whetū shadow puppets, and we look forward to seeing you at the More FM Mata Riki Kidsfest Parade!
